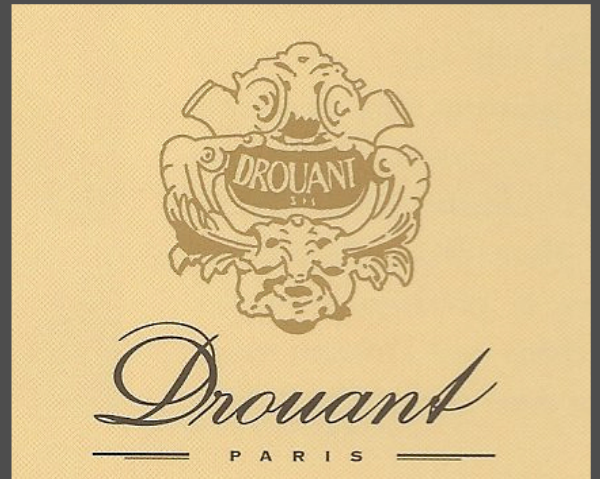
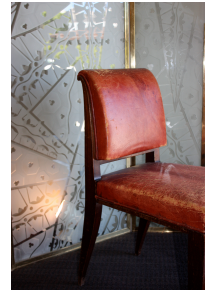


E.J. RUHLMANN

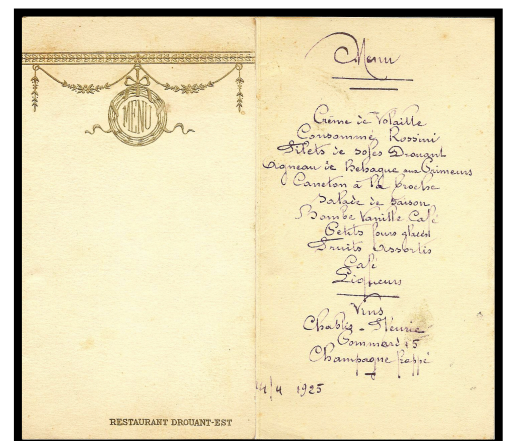
Another check point in defining class...

It is no question that the work of Emile-Jacques Ruhlmann has been pivotal in mapping the direction and style of sophisticated design. His genius concepts pushed the geometrical boundaries of design into a realm that has remained unparalleled since its inception. The Drouant Chair, as simple as it appears, has brought on a flock of imitations that have yet to reach the level of precision illustrated with this piece. It can be found in a number of high-end collections across the world, though most that are found are refinished. This model is completely original from 1925 and has never been repaired, refinished, or altered in any way. The chair also bears the artist's signature.
