Jean-Emile PUIFORCAT (1897-1945)

Very elegant silver plated and rosewood tea and coffee service set including a tray, teapot, coffee pot, sugar canister and creamer. Impressed manufacturer's mark to each piece: Puiforcat France and EP lozenge.

France circa 1986 Elegant "Etchea" tea and coffee service set, originally designed in sterling silver in 1928. Re-edited from 1986-1990.
